Salvation

Salvation is the process whereby one comes into a right relationship with a holy God. God is perfectly holy in every way. We, on the other hand are sinful (Romans 3:23). This situation separates us from the God that we long to fellowship with. We are in need of someone to save us or we will never have joy, and peace, and eternal life.

God's provision for the salvation of sinful man lies in the death of His Son (Luke 24:45-47). We have pardon for sin and redemption through the blood atonement of Christ (Matthew 1:21; 26:28; Acts 4:12; Romans 6:23; Ephesians 1:7; 2:8-10; I Timothy 1:15; Titus 2:14; Rev 5:9). Our response is one of faith (Mark 16:16; John 3:16; Acts 8:37; 16:30-31), and repentance (Acts 2:38; 3:19; I John 1:9).

- A. In the past sense (and tense) we are forgiven for past sin when we accept Jesus as Savior. We are declared innocent, even though we are guilty (Romans 5:1). That's justification. *We are saved from the guilt of sin (Romans 3:21-5:21).*
- B. In the present sense (and tense) Jesus takes care of the current influence sin might have by giving us the Holy Spirit to guide (help) us. That's sanctification. *We are saved from the power of sin (Romans 6:1-8:15).*
- C. In the future sense (and tense) we will be given a home in heaven where sin will not exist. That's glorification. *We will be saved from the presence of sin (Romans 8:16-30; I Corinthians 15:35-58).*

Jesus takes care of every angle: He has saved us, He is saving us, and He will save us. Hallelujah, what a Savior!!!

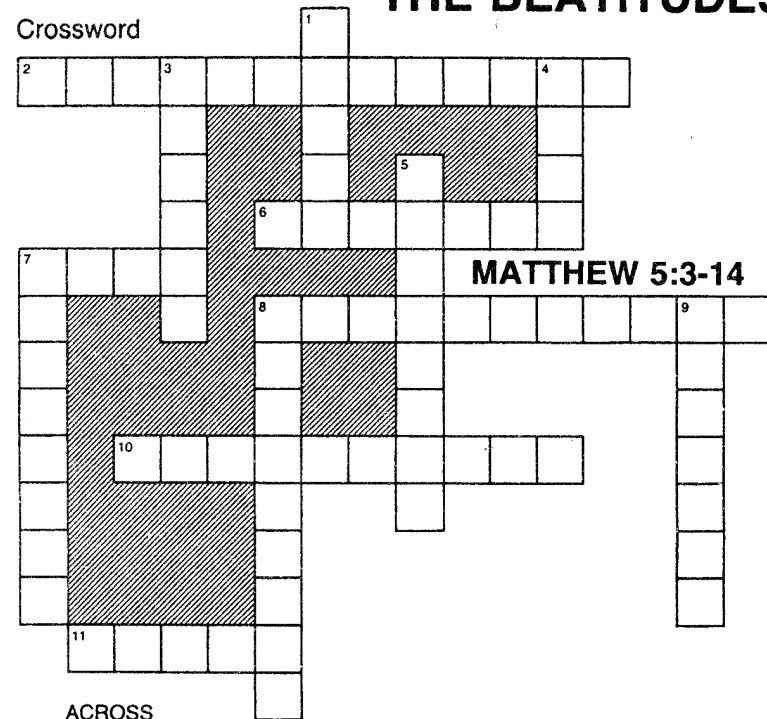

Harvest Festival November 4th, in the church yard with marshmallows and a bonfire.

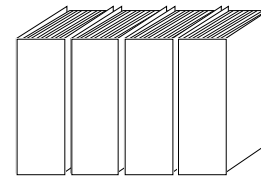

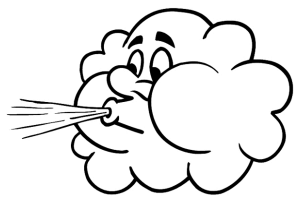
